This office has investigative files on all of the individuals identified by DMYTRYK as having been affiliated with the CP, as set forth in mylet of March 10th last summarizing the results of the interview with DMYTRYK. The information furnished by him is being channelized into appropriate files.

At the conclusion of the interview with him on March 8th last, DMYTRYK expressed himself as willing to cooperate with the interviewing agents at any time it was desired to contact nim further. On occasions, therefore, when it is felt that DMYTRYK may be of assistance in a particular matter, this office plans to recontact him on a confidential basis. The Bureau will be advised of pertinent results of such interviews when they arise.

It is noted that practically all of the information and identifications furnished by DMYTRYK to date have been largely subject to verification from other paste and present sources. He appeared to be entirely sincere in furnishing what he knew of the CP and CPA during the comparatively thort period of his own activity from 1944 to approximately the end of 1945. MYTRYK is not engaged in an occupation at the present time which is connected with a vital facility.
