<i>Dekemvriana</i>	December events of 1944
<i>deltio</i>	bulletin
<i>dini</i>	tempest
<i>ethnikofrosini</i>	national-mindedness
<i>geniko archigeio</i>	general headquarters
<i>kapetanos</i>	captain
<i>katharevousa</i>	an obsolete form of 'purified Greek' drawing on both ancient and modern linguistic elements; replaced by 'demotiki' (vernacular) in 1981
<i>kommouno-simmorites</i>	communist gangsters
<i>laiki aftodioikisi</i>	people's self-government
<i>laiki dimokratia/laokratia</i>	people's democracy
<i>mahitria</i>	woman fighter
<i>metapolitefsi</i>	change/transformation of regime
<i>miliciana</i>	female fighter of the Popular Front during the Spanish Civil War
<i>monarchofasistes</i>	monarcho-fascists
<i>paidomazoma</i>	evacuation of children
<i>politikos epitropos</i>	political commissar
<i>skoupa</i>	broom
<i>tagmata asfaleias</i>	security battalions
<i>(X)-tes</i>	anti-communist terrorist group organised by Giorgios Grivas, Cyprus-born general of the Greek Army
<i>ypefthini</i>	(female) partisan in charge; leader
